2. Three-year program


3. Prepares you to pass a state bar exam

The truth about your major & law school


It doesn't matter what you major in!

- Overall undergraduate GPA (of first awarded degree(s))
- **Rigor** of course load each semester at least **one** semester of 15 credit hours (3000 & 4000-level courses)
- Positive grade trends





KJD = apply in September/October


UGA LAW 3 + 3



Admissions Process

The 3+3 admissions process is only open to applicants who are currently enrolled as undergraduate students at the University of Georgia. You must meet all of the standard admissions requirements and apply to UGA Law. Admission to UGA Law through this process will be just as competitive as the standard admissions process.


Admissions Process

This admissions process is only open to applicants who have received or will receive their undergraduate degree from the University of Georgia. Qualified UGA undergraduates may apply to the University of Georgia School of Law without the previously required LSAT score. DISCLAIMER: UGA Scholars is very competitive. You are not guaranteed admission just by meeting the stated qualifications.

Before applying to UGA Law School through the UGA Scholars admissions process, you may have the opportunity to attend an Information Session. Check the UGA Law Recruiting Events page (law.uga.edu/recruitingevents) in early August for the date of this event.
