

Approved Volunteering Organizations

Things to Remember:

- Volunteering through these organizations on this list will be accepted or any other organization of your choice, that allows you to shadow/volunteer in an office setting learning about ethics. Please email <u>tqadri@uga.edu</u> if you are unsure.
- You may volunteer at multiple sites.
- You must **document and get the signature of a staff member** or someone in leadership for each volunteer site; see volunteer log sheet on the ppao.uga.edu website.
- You have from August 19th to December 11th to complete 20 hours of volunteering and submit documentation to the program coordinator via email (tqadri@uga.edu). Approval for experiential learning is pending. Once approved, if you wish to have credit for Experiential Learning, volunteering must be completed by December 3rd, 2024.
- Volunteering may take a while to set up, therefore students are strongly encouraged to **start the process of volunteering early** in the semester.
- Be aware not all volunteer sites may be accepting volunteers.
- To get the most from the program, students are encouraged to step outside their comfort zone and try a new volunteer opportunity. This will also be helpful on your professional school application if you challenge yourself.
- Volunteering must be completed during Fall semester (August 19th to December 11th, 2024 different date for experiential learning)
